Why Exeter?

- ✓ **Exeter** (population 105,000) is an historic city 305 km south-west of London. It has magnificent Gothic cathedral, many lovely old buildings and a variety of interesting museums. It is the county town of Devon, situated in beautiful hilly countryside, close to the South Devon coast and Dartmoor National Park.
- ✓ Exeter is not overcrowded with overseas students and offers a typically British environment in which to study.

Why learn with InterEducation?
