### Why Portsmouth?

- ✓ **Portsmouth** (population 190,000) is an important port situated on the south coast of England, 120 kms south of London. Old Portsmouth overlooks the busy, historic maritime harbour, famous for its historic ships - most notably Nelson's "Victory", while the attractive seaside resort area of Southsea has four miles of seafront and views across to the Isle of Wight.
- ✓ Portsmouth is not overcrowded with overseas students and offers a typically British environment in which to study.

### Why learn with InterEducation?
